<u>Re</u>: nomination of the "Grand Bouquet Cannabique" of Defenders of Human and Citizen Rights for the 2021 Nobel Peace Prize at the occasion of the 30<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the CIRC.

Because of your prominent social position, as member of the European parliament, national parliament, or government, as university professor of social and religious sciences, history, philosophy, law or theology, or as director of a peace research institute or a foreign policy institute, you belong to an exclusive group of people which Alfred Nobel considered worthy to judge about questions of war and peace and to nominate candidates for the Peace Prize that bears his name. We have the pleasure to address you in that capacity.

The Drugs Peace Institute (DPI) has had the opportunity in the past to successfully propose Drugs Pacifists, people who contributed to the goal to end the War on Drugs, for nomination to the Nobel Peace Prize. This year, 26 years after the first nomination of Professor Mauricio Mamani Pocoaca of Bolivia, 7 years after the nomination of President José (Pépé) Mujica of Uruguay and 1 year after the nomination of Filipino Senator Mme. Leila de Lima, the DPI, had the privilege to nominate on January 31st, 2021, French cannabis activists and their activist friends abroad for a combined candidacy under the name of "Grand Bouquet Cannabique of Defenders of Human and Citizen Rights".

This event is organized to celebrate on October 14, 2021 the 30th anniversary of the CIRC, the Collective for Information and Research on Cannabis and its defense of the multiple uses of hemp, its cultivation and distribution.
